PROJECTS AND UPDATES

HEALTH CARE UPDATE

Our first sponsored student, Adeltha Zilimu, is now employed at St. Francis Rwambaizi Health Center as a Clinical Officer. She has also received additional training in radiology. Adeltha is helping Sr. Dorosela with the care of pregnant women using the ultrasound machine donated by one of our generous supporters! We are very happy for her and have now come full circle with one of our medical school graduates employed at the health center.

Partly due to our support, St. Francis Rwambaizi Health Center now has a new doctor, Dr. Makonge, who works with Sr. Dorosela full-time. We are also grateful to the generous donor who supported the Outreach Program. Hundreds of pregnant women and families have been served with 160 babies delivered at the health center from January to May 2021. This was a 30% increase from the same time the previous year and a significant achievement in the number of safe, healthy deliveries.

Sr. Dorosela reported that the number of women coming for labor and delivery has increased since the addition of a new doctor and Adeltha performing the ultrasounds. Due to the increased need for services, another one of our sponsored students, Elivinus Alfred, has been added to help Sr. Dorosela. He recently completed his midwifery course at Rubya Nursing School. Sr. Dorosela has requested funding for another delivery bed as the Center has only one that is very old.

Visiting nurses to the remote rural villages provide health education to mothers and fathers on safe deliveries. The nurses also provided frequent medical checks for expectant mothers and mosquito nets to help prevent malaria. Medicines are available for young children and pregnant women to prevent and treat diseases.

Malnutrition in Tanzania is a significant problem. In addition to the medical services, the Rwambaizi health team teach families to eat a balanced diet. Knowledge of how to better use local foods to meet their nutritional needs results in less malnourishment and helps to keep families healthy. We thank God and our supporters for the improvements in health care in this very poor region.


